## N25 Bandon/Sarsfield Interchanges Upgrade

### Progress Update

10<sup>th</sup> January 2012

Construction works on the N25 Bandon/Sarsfield Interchanges Upgrade Scheme recommenced after the Christmas break on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2012. The works are currently on course for completion by the due date of July 2013 and, in order to ensure that the works remain on track it is proposed to significantly extend the working hours over the coming period. Starting from Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2012, drilling works in the area south of the existing N25 will be extended to a seven day working week until they have been completed. No disruption to traffic will arise as a result of these works.

Placing of the bridge beams on the western span of the Bandon Road Roundabout area will take place during week commencing Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2012. These works will necessitate local traffic diversions with traffic approaching the Bandon Road Roundabout from the Ballincollig Bypass side being diverted via the Curraheen Road. All necessary signage will be in place and the works are being carried out at night in order to minimise traffic disruption. Works will get underway at 11.00 p.m. each night with the road fully reopened to traffic by 6.00 a.m. the following morning. It is expected that placing of the bridge beams at this structure will take 4 nights to complete from the night of Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2012 to the night of Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2012 inclusive.

Over the coming weeks works will increasingly focus on the Sarsfield Road Roundabout end of the site. Works required in this area will include construction of a revised roundabout layout, construction of a new overbridge, installation of new culverts under the existing and proposed road, reinforced earth wall construction etc. Minor restrictions and partial road closures will be required from time to time in association with these works and details of these traffic management proposals will be issued in advance as the scheme progresses. Every effort will of course continue to be made to minimise disruption to traffic flow.
